The UAB Chronic Hypertension and Pregnancy Project (CHAP), a multicenter, randomized trial enrolling up to 5,700 pregnant women over six years to evaluate potential treatment of mild chronic hypertension in pregnancy, is the most comprehensive study of the issue ever undertaken.
